



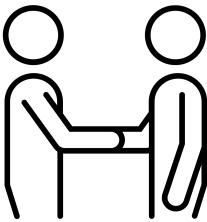

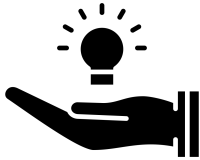


The SAFC and SBS have partnered for the **FULL TILT Short Documentary Initiative**.

Initiative is a new idea.



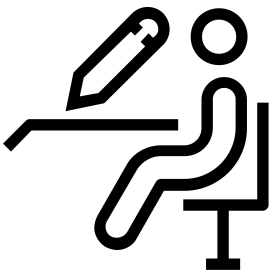
The SAFC and SBS will help the **development** and **production** three short documentaries.

The teams are:



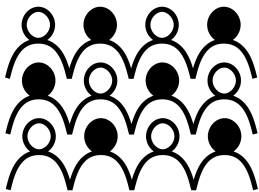

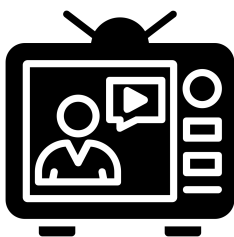

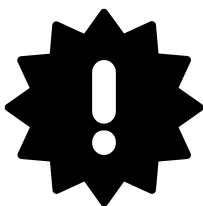
FULL TILT is for **diverse** film makers.
