Electric Dreams is a three-day creative industries conference looking at how technology is changing the arts, taking place at Lot Fourteen in Adelaide from 19 to 21 February, 2020.

The conference program includes world class presentations and panels from international arts organisations that are working at the cutting edge of creative and commercial development using technology to find new ways to connect with audiences, creating the innovative theatre, gallery, museum and film experiences for the audiences of the future.

What is on offer?

The South Australian Film Corporation will support four SA creatives to attend the conference, with two of the delegate passes designated for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander delegates only.

The SAFC will cover the full cost of the registration at \$380 as well as providing funding towards cost of travel for regional or remote applicants.

Who is eligible?

South Australian creatives, looking to explore opportunities to diversify their practice.

You will need to demonstrate an interest in creating content and to demonstrate how the conference fits in with your overall skills and career development plan.

The SAFC is committed to supporting increased participation in the industry of people from under-represented groups including women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, practitioners from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds, those who are Deaf or with disability, from LGBTQIA+ communities and from regional and remote areas.

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How will my application be assessed?

This funding round will be assessed competitively.

Applications will be assessed against the following criteria:

- Demonstrable experience, interest or ambition to develop stories
- The strength of skills development plan, articulating how this conference fits into it

How do I apply?

Before you apply, please familiarise yourself with the SAFC's Terms of Trade.

Applications close on Monday 20 January at 11.59pm ACDT.

Successful applicants will be notified via email by Friday 24 January.

Successful applicants will enter into a grant agreement with the SAFC and will need to provide an acquittal within 30 days of the conference. The SAFC will purchase the ticket on behalf of the successful applicants. The decision on applications is final.
