## First Nations Internships at Channel 44



The South Australian Film Corporation has partnered with Adelaide free to air community television station Channel 44 to create new career pathways for South Australian First Nations screen practitioners.

The partnership includes support for up to five First Nations identified interns who will be mentored at Channel 44 across key creative and crew roles. Each internship requires up to 80 hours of unpaid work that will include hands-on experience in television production, along with opportunities to learn new skills and create original content.

Channel 44 has a social media following of 10,000 people with an audience viewership of 65,000 within Adelaide and SA regional towns. The station delivers regular TV programming including *SA Sports Show* at three hours per week and *Our Time* at two hours per week.

### What is on offer?

Up to five internships will be created with interns to be mentored by experienced Channel 44 staff, with roles in on set production and within the production office.

Positions and duties available for internships across multiple roles include:

- Operations Assistant (Production Assistant)
- Web Development
- Production Coordinator
- Social Media and Marketing
- Broadcast Assistant (Production Assistant)
- Editor/VFX/Animation
- Other casual production crew opportunities - hair, makeup, wardrobe.

### Who is eligible?

Applicants must:

- Be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- Be a South Australian Resident as defined by the [SAFC Terms of Trade](#).
- Have evidence of previous credits (preferable)

## What are the expectations of the participants?

Participants must:

- Commit to 80 hours of internship with Channel 44:
  - Office based preferred 9am-5pm x 1 day per week, but hours may be flexible as negotiated with Channel 44.
  - Some weekend and out of hours work required.
- Be able to work as part of a team.

## How do I apply?

Applicants will be selected via an interview process with Channel 44.
