

Presented by the South Australian Film Corporation, SAGE: South Australian Game Exhibition is South Australia's premier event for video game developers to exhibit their works. Hosted at the Adelaide Studios on 16-17 February, 2024, SAGE 2024 will display 32 South Australian video games studios and developers for the general public.

Games will be spread over two exhibition areas: the SAGE Main Showcase, and the SAGE Elevate Showcase.

There are two SAGE Awards with attached prizes on offer to exhibitors: the SAGE Elevate Award and the SAGE Award for Best in Exhibition (Grand Jury Prize).

## SAGE Elevate Award

Each of the seven exhibitors in the SAGE 2024 Elevate Showcase will be eligible for the SAGE Elevate Award.

The Prize seeks to select an outstanding South Australian video game. The winning company will receive a prize of \$1,000 in legal services from SAGE partner Cam Rogers Legal, to be awarded as a voucher/certificate from Cam Rogers Legal.

The aim of the SAGE Elevate Award is to select the game in the SAGE Elevate Showcase that demonstrates its excellence against the following criteria:

- the innovation, quality, originality and creative ambition of the product;
- the quality and rigour of all presented materials;
- the potential for positive professional development outcomes for the team and their project.

## SAGE Award for Best in Exhibition (Grand Jury Prize)

Each of the 32 exhibitors across both the SAGE 2024 Elevate Showcase and SAGE 2024 Main Showcase will be eligible to receive the SAGE Award for Best in Exhibition (Grand Jury Prize).

The Prize seeks to select an outstanding South Australian video game. The winning company will receive a \$2,000 prize, to be awarded as a grant by the SAFC.

The aim of the SAFC SAGE Award for Best in Exhibition (Grand Jury Prize) is to select the game that demonstrates its excellence against the following criteria:

- the innovation, quality, originality and creative ambition of the product;
- the quality and rigour of all presented materials;
- the benefits to the South Australian games industry and its reputation as a centre of excellence.
